

WEEKS BEGINNING: **23.11.20**

**YR - Remote Learning**

This week we are learning through the story 'Owl Babies' by Martin Waddell

The **PSED** focus is caring for animals.

Phonics	Introduce – ow, ee/or, ng	Use the Jolly Phonics website to introduce the action and pure sound of each letter. Listen to the song to reinforce the sound.
Writing	j, z, w  information writing  name writing	Handwriting practice. Ensure the pencil is held correctly in a 'frog' grip. Start each letter in the correct place.  Write a fact about owls. Use the internet / information books to find out about owls.  Writing own name plus names of family members forming letters correctly.
Reading	Story books Owl Babies Owls	Read/ watch on YouTube Owl Babies by Martin Waddell. Discuss characters. Encourage children to predict what might happen next. Look within the text for key words covered so far. Questions - What did you enjoy most about the story? Which is your favourite page?  This week the focus words are: <b>dad, dog</b>
Maths	Deepen knowledge of numbers to 8  Sorting objects	Chanting numbers to 20 as a warmup.  Children find natural objects and sort them. Encourage children to explain the criteria used
The World	Art using natural materials	Encourage the children to use the natural objects to make an owl picture. You could use sticks, leaves, moss, grass etc
Art & Craft	Printing/collage picture	Use white paint/ cotton wool/ card to make an owl. Add details with pens/ cut out paper: eyes, beak
